Abstract: This document is a template for all GLS submissions. It uses predefined styles to standardize submissions formatting and streamline subsequent publication in the conference proceedings. Please use the predefined styles to format all text in this document; this enables the proceedings editors to do their work without unnecessary and soul sucking tediousness. Abstracts should be 150 words or less.

Section Headers

Let's talk headers. The title is in the predefined Heading 1 style. Section headers are in Heading 2 style, with sub-section headers (sbelow) in Heading 3 style (with each word capitalized) or Heading 4 style (with only the first word capitalized and a period at the end) as needed, depending on your level of nestedness. Do you feel nested? We hope so. It sounds rather cosey and snug. Titles and headers should not contain any special character because they gunk up the magic formatting machine.

Body Text

The many body text for the entire document is in "Normal" style. Note that is in Calibri font, size 11 point, left justified, single space. Leave one space between sentences. The two-space thing went out with long ago; don't fight it. Just let it happen.

The margins for your entire paper should be 1 inch on all sides. Leave use one blank like (a hard return adding using your enter/return key) between paragraphs and between sections (but not between a section header and the text that follows it). This gives us some nice white space between paragraphs but otherwise keeps content nicely bundled. Do not use page breaks; they are a veritable sandal thrown into the cogs of this well-oiled machine.

[block quote] When I got chickens for my farm everyone and everything I read said they have a "pecking order" (hierarchy) in which "lesser" (lower ranking) chickens often got pecked and hurt. We stocked up on medicine in the event we needed to treat harassed chickens. However, our chickens live in a very large chicken house with two big inside rooms and a very large amount of fenced in space outside. They also regularly get to roam free. We have in three years never seen one chicken harass another and have never once had to use our medicine, save when one chicken was attacked by a Bald Eagle. The extended quote should be preceded and followed by one blank line. Preference given to all things "radiantly feathered."

A word on page bottoms.

DO NOT use page breaks, page numbers, or running heads. They are all molasses in the gas tank. If you must use notes, please use Microsoft's footnotes to generate them. They are magical and work as gentle floaty pockets of protection for all your interesting asides when we go to press¹. For

emphasis in your text, use **bold** or *italics*. Both are stylish and friendly to the production pipeline plumbing system.

Page Length and Review Process

Submissions vary in length and review process depending on submission type. The following list gives the maximum length and review process for each submission type; it also serves as an example of how to format lists in your submission. You can use either bulleted lists or numbered lists, just stick with the Microsoft native formatting. Page lengths include all references and figures.

- Presentation: up to 7 pages in length, review is double-anonymized.
- Symposium: up to 7 pages in length, review is not double-anonymized.
- Panel: up to 2 pages in length, review is not double-anonymized.
- Workshop: up to 2 pages in length, review is not double-anonymized.
- Well Played: up to 2 pages in length, review is double-anonymized.
- Poster: up to 2 pages in length, review is double-anonymized.
- Game Showcase: up to 2 pages in length, review is double-anonymized.
- Hall of Failure: up to 2 pages in length, review is double-anonymized.

Authors List

If you are submitting for a session format listed above as "double-anonymized," then you need to remove all references to you and your co-authors so that the reviewers do not know who wrote this masterpiece. For the title byline, just list the words "Author, Institution." For in-text self-citations, use (Author, actual year) such as (Author, 2021) so that the date of the publication is known but not the author. The same logic applies to the References List (discussed below).

Figures and Tables

All figures and tables must be referred to in your text using parentheses and the table or figure number (Table 1). Color figures may be included, but the print proceedings will be in black and white, so please be sure that they will reproduce acceptably without color (see Figure 1). Both tables and figures should be left justified. Hugs are good but not when it's text wrapping around your figure.

Table and figure titles precede the table/figure and are left justified. The table/figure number is in bold on one line and the caption is unbolded on the next line. Capitalize only the first word of a table title and end it with a period. Capitalize every word of a figure title and omit the period.

All figures should be .jpeg or .gif format and 300 dpi minimum. When they go to press, they will generally be scaled to 600 pixels in height, so a higher resolution is better if you want your figures to pop off the page in glorious detail without smearing and smudging and blurring (oh my!).

Citation and Reference Style

Use APA7 reference style throughout your paper and the reference section. Please refer to the APA 7 Publication Manual, <u>online APA Style Guide</u> or <u>Purdue OWL website</u> for full details and more extensive examples. Apply the reference style to accomplish the correct indentation. Remember to italicize all game names (e.g., *Little Nightmares*), and cite them using APA style. Games are resources too and the APA style guide has finally included them explicitly in their style guide. Clearly we've hit the big time, everyone.

Acknowledgments

Who doesn't like to be thanked? Acknowledgments go just before your references section. Leave the section out of your initial submission if needed to insure double-anonymization-ation.
